Maria Maria at Danville's Rose Garden has an upscale and welcoming feel with happy hour deals that appeal to the masses.

Campo di Bocce in Livermore scores massive points for its great Italian food, stellar wine selection, bocce ball courts. Guests of Campo di Bocce tend to be more affluent and are likely to be pre-approved by moms. Also in Livermore is the popular First Street Ale House. This four-star Yelp favorite is a sure bet for meeting eligible singles. "The ambiance is really open bright and social. The menu is reasonable and I had a fabulous time with my girlfriends.
